Reports of Committees

Personnel, Wage & Salary Committee

• Mr. Kirchner reported that the salaries accounted for a very significant portion of the budget. The union contract is in its second year. Mr. Kirchner also stated that over-time and part-time hours will need to be monitored due to the Convention Center. Security hours are also expected to increase due to the Convention Center. The budgeted amount for salaries for 2008 is \$633,000.00. Mr. Matthews reported that he estimated \$109,000.00 for medical benefits.

Other Business Items

Executive Director's Report

- Mr. Vergenes stated that once striping at the East King Street site occurs, people who park there can be ticketed and towed. The minimal fine would be \$200.00. We just need to contact the police when the painting has been completed.
- Mr. Matthews reported that revenue is coming in. He also reported that extras for The East King Street site is cutting into the reserves.
- Mr. Vergenes reported that a rendering of the new garage will be displayed at the site. Mr. Matthews stated that he is working on getting a price.

Miscellaneous Business

- Ms. Riggs reported that the RRTA is sending out RFP for museum garage. There should be more information available by the next meeting.
- Ms. Riggs and Mr. Matthews will be meeting with the Lancaster Convention Center Authority on January 14, 2008, to finalize the plans for parking.
