## Free Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Begins April 20

Electric vehicle (EV) charging stations will open on Friday, April 20, for public use in all downtown LPA parking garages. This free new service will help reduce the carbon footprint in the City of Lancaster.

The EV stations, the first public charging stations in the city, are located near the entrances of each garage and can be identified by bright green painted sections and signs. The stations will be able to accommodate: six vehicles in Prince St., and two each in Penn Square, E. King St., Duke St. and Water St.



To use, customers must first download the [Chargepoint app](#) on the App Store or Google Play and go to the Lancaster EV location. A credit card is used to register on the app, but it won't be charged for EV charging at LPA garages.

Depending on the vehicle make and model of the vehicle, the EV charging will take different lengths of time. When finished, patrons will be notified via the app, and should move their vehicles so others can use the service.

## Get the ParkLancaster App for On-Street Parking



Download new parking app on the App Store or Google Play

- Set up account with your license plate number, state, and payment info.
- Find open space; select time to park.
- Add zone number from signs and stickers near your parking space.
- Get reminders 15 minutes before your time runs out; if needed, **add more time.**

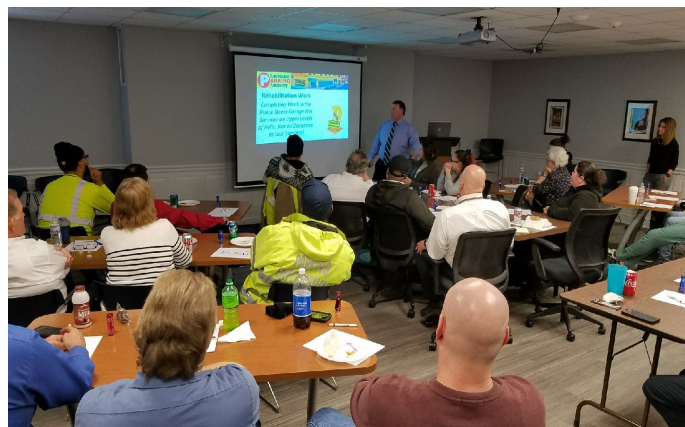
