Free Electric Vehicle Charging in Garages



Electric vehicle (EV) charging stations will open in April for public use in all downtown parking garages.

The EV stations, the first public charging stations in the city, are located near the entrances of

each garage and can be identified by bright green painted sections and signs. There will be seven in total: three in Prince St. and one each in Penn Square, E. King St., Duke St. and Water St.

All can be used for free. To use, customers must first download the on the App Store or on Google Play and find the Lancaster EV location. A credit card must be used to register on the app, but it won't be charged for EV charging at LPA garages.

EV charging will take different lengths of time, depending on the vehicle make and model. When the charger is finished, you will be notified via the app so you can move your vehicle so others can use the service.

How to Use ParkLancaster app

Pay for parking from mobile device:

- 1.Download for Apple and
- -Create account with e-mail address
- -Add license plate number and state
- 2. Set up method of payment
- 3. Park and look for zone number signs/stickers around meters
- -Select amount of time, confirm, touch start parking
- -Countdown clock begins you will be notified when 15 minutes is left
