- Get reminders 15 minutes before your time runs out; if needed, add more time.

Parking in Garages During a Snow Emergency

A snow emergency is only enacted by the City when there is anticipated or 8" or more of snow. If a snow emergency is enacted, it will be announced on media, website and social media outlets. For more information on the City's snow emergency procedures, read <u>here.</u>

- The LPA will provide downtown residents free parking in all LPA garages on a firstcome, first-serve basis for the duration of the snow emergency to allow streets to be cleared.
- If one garage is full, residents may park in another garage.
- Residents should pull a ticket upon entry.
- When the snow emergency is lifted, residents have two hours (unless a different time is noted) to remove vehicles. The hourly rate will apply to those parking longer than two hours.
