Demolition Ceremony Kicks Off New Garage, Public Library



It's underway! A Sept. 24 demolition ceremony was the start of work on the new Christian Street Garage and Lancaster Public Library on the north side of the new Ewell Plaza.

Dignitaries in attendance, from left included Nicholas Boyer,

president, Lancaster Public Library Board of Trustees; Ray D'Agostino, chair, Lancaster CRIZ Authority; Mayor Danene Sorace; Larry Cohen, LPA executive director, and Kim

Bracey, Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development. Each used a sledgehammer to symbolically break a piece of the concrete wall that will be torn down to make way for the new structure.



The building will include the library, parking garage, retail space, and public art. Demolition for the \$28 million project will begin soon with an expected completion date of mid-2021.
