



## New Christian Street Garage Construction Underway

Demolition of the old structures has been completed, and the new \$30 million Christian Street Garage in Ewell Plaza is underway. It will include the Lancaster Public Library, retail and event spaces, and public parking. It is expected to open mid-2021.



## Prince Street Garage Adds Pay Machines

Pay machines have been installed in the street-level lobbies of the Prince Street Garage to allow daily visitors to pay for parking before returning to their vehicles. They will aid in faster exiting from the garage.

This is the latest change to enhance customer service in the garage, said Larry J. Cohen, executive director. Other upgrades include the upgrading and opening of all four exit lanes, new signage, restriping, and the installation of Electric Vehicle (EV) charging stations.

Daily parkers can find one pay machine on the street-level Orange St. elevator lobby and the second on the street-level elevator lobby by the Orange St./Binn Park entrance. Parkers should take care to remember to their ticket with them and pay for parking before returning to their vehicles. Then, they insert their paid ticket at the exit lane machine to get out of the garage.
