## Prince Street Parking Garage Jury Parking Dates

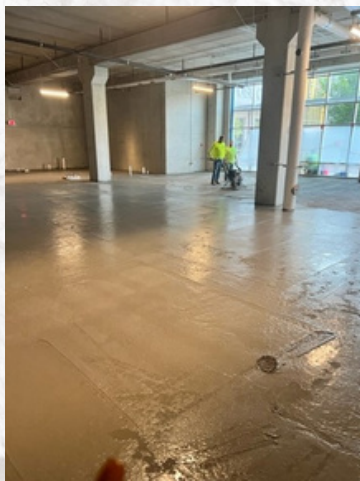
October: 2nd, 10th, 16th, 18th, 23rd & 30th

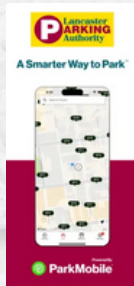
